

Glove Care & Maintenance

Proper maintenance of a Valle glove include both things that you should and should not do. The biggest enemies of a quality leather baseball glove are water, oil, and heat. Too much exposure to these elements will shorten the life of your glove. **Never under any circumstances place your glove in a microwave oven!** This will damage the glove and void the warranty.

Positive things you should do are to keep your glove clean and periodically inspect it for any loose lacing that may happen over time.

Breaking I n Your Glove

The best advice for breaking in your glove, is to not look for short cuts. Play catch and use your glove as often as you can. This will allow the natural oils in the leather to soften it, and let you form and shape the glove the way you like it.

A glove that is used often will periodically need cleaning to remove dirt and also pull out any sweat inside the glove that could shorten the life of the leather. We recommend the use of petroleum jelly in this case. Put a thin coat and rub into the leather with your fingers both inside and outside the glove, including the lacing. Remove with a clean cloth.

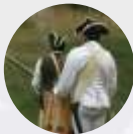
